

Guidelines for setting Question Paper
For newly introduced semester system in post graduate courses

In Case of 80 marks Question Papers,

01. The Question Paper will be divided into two sections "A" and "B".
02. In Section "A" there will be objective questions covering the entire Units/Contents of the Paper. The number of Questions will be 10 (each of one mark) and there will be 5 short answer type questions (each of two marks) and In Case of 50 Marks question paper in Section "A" there will be 4 objectives questions covering the entire Units/Contents of the paper (each of 1 mark) and 3 short answer type questions (each of two marks) in case of 50 marks question paper, however it will be compulsory.
03. In Section "B" there will be descriptive answer type of questions from all 4 Units or 5 Units of equal marks 15 or 12 marks for each question of total 60 marks with 50% internal choice of questions . -

Further it is clarified that a Question paper will comprise of an alternative question in each unit where as a candidate shall have to answer one question from each unit or any 4 out of 8 or any 5 out of 10 Questions of the Paper concerned

Max Marks - 80
Min Passing Marks - 29

Section - "A"

- Q.1 Objective type 10 questions, all will be compulsory) - One mark for each question.
10 Marks (1X10= 10)
- Q.2 5 Short Answer type questions, carrying 02 marks for each, all are compulsory –
10 Marks (2X5 = 10)

Section - "B"

- Q.3 Descriptive type of Question of 60 Marks. **60 Marks (15x4 = 60 or 12x5=60)**
Descriptive answer type of Questions from all 4 Units or 5 Units of equal Marks 15 or 12 respectively there will be internal choice i.e. an alternative question in each Unit will be given and Candidate shall have to answer one question form each Unit.

Section - "A"

- Q.1 Objective type 04 questions, all will be compulsory) - One mark for each question.
04 Marks (1X4= 04)
- Q.2 3Short Answer type questions, carrying 02 marks for each, all are compulsory –
06 Marks (2X3 =06)

Section - "B"

- Q.3 Descriptive answer type of Questions from all 4 Units or 5 Units of 10 or 08 Marks for each respectively. There will be internal choice. **40 Marks (4x10 Or 5x8= 40)**
